In 2012 after a deep process of prayer, evaluation and planning the Lord gave us a renewed vision, mission and a seven-year strategic plan (2012-2018). In 2016 we completed 5 years of our strategic plan. We want to share with you what God has allowed us to accomplish.

MISSION

Potter's House is a Christ-centered organization that fights poverty in Guatemala by promoting a personal relationship with God through Jesus Christ while deploying holistic development programs that focus on at-risk children and youth.

VISION

That every beneficiary child and youth, through their personal relationship with God, will reach the maturity they need to pursue their own holistic development and will contribute in the fight against poverty by influencing their family, community and nation.

2012-2018 STRATEGIC PLAN EMPHASIS



CHRIST-CENTERED

Sharing the Gospel with each participant (beneficiary, partner, staff), thus contributing to the Great Commission and honoring God in all that we do (programs, partnerships, and support services).



EXPANSION

Replicate the work model and fight poverty in other communities in Guatemala as well as share our management experience with other ministries and organizations.



WORK MODEL

Establish community centers where the DEM (Develop, Empower, Multiply) process of transformation takes place in order to avoid dependency and promote sustainability.

KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS



Visiting families to share the Gospel and pray for them. 21,901 people impacted.



Through different activities such as VBS, Kids Camp, men and women's retreat and weekly devotionals.



More than 20 trips to 31 poor communities in rural areas of Guatemala. Pilot projects include: medical clinics, prayer visits and VBS.



These are located in Guatemala city, and one office in Chiquimula.



There are currently 270 students enrolled in the education program. 32 will graduate in the next 2 years.



95% of the students enrolled in the nutritional program have reached their ideal weight and height.



Medical attention is provided in different areas such as: Pediatrics, chronic illnesses and family practice.



Life quality, safety and health are improved along with human dignity. More than 1,000 people were impacted.



Default rate is 11%. The most common business is selling food. More than 3,750 people were impacted.
